The cricket season is now under way and the Guernsey Cricket Board's annual school tournaments are quickly approaching. Following their help with the School's Cricket Programme, Appleby will be supporting all three tournaments.

The KGV Playing Fields will play host to the Year 6 tournament on Friday 11th June, the Girls tournament on Thursday the 17th June and the year 5 on Friday the 18th June. We are expecting a good turn out this year with 12 teams entered into both the year 5 tournament and the year 6 tournament and 8 teams in the girls. All the action is scheduled to kick off at 1pm with an approximate finishing time of 5pm.

The tournaments provide competitive cricket for the schools where the youngsters can put into practice their skills learned in P.E. lessons.

Community Cricket Coach Hannah Mechem commented, "It's always great to see the children so enthusiastic about the game and taking pride in representing their school."
