Barclays Wealth Evening League MVP for June and July 2010

Outstanding contributions earn two local cricketers the Barclays Wealth Most Valuable Player of the Month Awards for June and July.

Each month the Guernsey Cricket Board chooses one player from across all five of the Barclays Wealth Evening League Divisions to receive the award. Praxis Corinthians B player Tim Belton won the award in June and Paul Oliver from The Jazz Hats won the award in July.

'We are into the business part of the Barclays Wealth Evening League season now and these performances have put Tim and Paul's respective Clubs right up there in the standings,' said Chief Executive Officer of the Guernsey Cricket Board Mark Latter.

Belton had two impressive performances on the strip at the beginning of June with a 40 and a 55 not out. He then finished the month with 82 runs to help his team to the top of the Barclays Wealth Evening League 2. His strong performance has continued throughout July with 54 not out and 33 not out and with a total of 17 points looks a likely contender for the division's overall MVP award which will be presented at the end of the season.

Oliver starred with both bat and ball in the Barclays Wealth Evening League 3 in July to win the month's award. His tally includes 4 for 30 including a hat-trick and, then led the team home with 95 not out to cap an outstanding game. Scores of 31 and 71 have been backed up with figures of 3 for 31 when thrown the ball in the rest of the month.

Belton and Oliver received a bottle of champagne donated by sponsor Barclays Wealth and a £30 voucher to use at the ICG. The monthly and overall winners will be announced and presented with their awards at the annual dinner at the end of season.

'There have been some very impressive performances this year and it's great to see players from different divisions winning the monthly MVP awards.
