Matches will be played at the Kinrara Oval, Bayuemas Oval and Selangor Turf Club all in Kuala Lumpur.

On the selection of the Squad the National Coach **Andy Cornford** said, “Ever since we returned from the World Cricket League 6 in Singapore in 2009, everyone involved with Guernsey cricket had been relishing the challenge of a return to cricket in Asia. This tournament will be tough, not only due to the strength of our opposition but because of the harsh heat and humidity playing in that part of the world. Having said that we are better prepared and know to some extent what to expect.

The players have been working hard at their 50 over skills and the challenge for us is to start this tournament as we ended in Singapore. We have a strong squad and it’s exciting to see some younger players making the 50 over squad for the first time. I’m confident they’ll go well”

Commenting on the upcoming tournament National Manager **Pete Vidamour** said, “World Cricket League 6 in Malaysia will be the culmination of months of hard work and commitment from the Guernsey squad and everyone involved is looking forward to the tournament. The standard of competition will be very high and we are expecting some hard games but we are confident that we have a strong squad who can rise to the challenge.”
