The aim of the Guernsey fund-raising appeal is to raise funds for the development of the Teenage Cancer Trust unit in Southampton - the place where our local young people will go to get their treatment. The units are totally unique to teenagers and act as a 'home-from-home' for our teenagers in a difficult time in their development. The first fund-raising goal is £100,000 to help towards one bedroom within the unit. The more funds raised, the more facilities we can aim to support.
