



Pepsi ICC World Cricket League Division Six

Guernsey – 279 for 6 from 50 overs (Lee Savident 82, Jeremy Frith 82, Stuart Le Prevost 52)

Fiji – 171 all from 42.3 overs (Gary Rich 2 for 22, Frith 2 for 50)

GUERNSEY made it two wins out of two in the Pepsi ICC World Cricket League Division Six after they defeated Fiji by 108 runs at the Bayuemas Oval, Kuala Lumpur, today.

The victory goes with their nine run win over Jersey on Saturday.

Having won the toss, Guernsey batted first and posted a formidable total of 279 off their 50 overs.

Opener and former Hampshire professional Lee Savident hit 82 while all-rounder Jeremy Frith also struck 82 and captain Stuart Le Prevost weighed in with 52 down the order.

In reply, Fiji never really got out of the blocks as they were penned back by a Guernsey bowling attack that certainly performed a lot better than they did on Saturday.

Veteran off-spinner Gary Rich returned the best figures of two wickets for 22 runs as the spoils were shared about.

Frith also picked two wickets with his left-arm spin to ensure that he was named man-of-the-match for the second day running.

Fiji ended up falling well short on 171.

‘We could’ve asked more with that start,’ said Le Prevost, ‘but I’m very pleased with today. It was a proper performance.’ ‘The boys deserve their day off tomorrow.’

Guernsey now have a rest day on Monday before they meet Kuwait on Tuesday who had their match with Jersey today rained off and will now have to instead play the Caesareans tomorrow.

The day’s other match saw hosts Malaysia defeat Nigeria by 79 runs in a rain affected game.
