Guernsey v Nigeria, rained off

GUERNSEY'S rise out of Pepsi ICC World Cricket League Division Six, was delayed when the Greens' crucial match with Nigeria at the Selangor Turf Club was rained off today.

After winning the toss, Nigeria batted first and were restricted to 18 for five thanks to some inspired bowling by Guernsey's opening bowlers – Jamie Nussbaumer and Lee Savident. However, the Samians went off the boil to allow Nigeria to recover to 163 for 7 in the 47th over before the rain came down and that was that.

The match cannot be replayed on Thursday's rest day as Nigeria are already playing Jersey in a rearranged match.

A decision has yet to be made as to whether Guernsey will meet Nigeria on Saturday or the two points will be shared by the pair.

A single point will ensure that Guernsey are promoted to Division Five.

The island side have a rest day tomorrow before meeting Malaysia on Friday.

The hosts lost to Jersey at the Bayuemas Oval today.
