Guernsey v Malaysia, Kinrara Oval

Malaysia 208 for 9 off 50 overs (GH Smit 3 for 31, Jeremy Frith 2 for 32, Jamie Nussbaumer 2 for 38)

Guernsey 211 for 8 off 49.3 overs (Tom Kimber 82*, David Hooper 45, Tim Ravenscroft 21, Jamie Nussbaumer 17*)

Guernsey won by two wickets

GUERNSEY capped off their Pepsi ICC World Cricket League Division Six adventure with a truly remarkable victory over Malaysia at the Kinrara Oval, Kuala Lumpur, today.

The day before, the Sarnians had defeated the hosts to ensure they reached their goal of promotion to Division Five.

In the final, Guernsey had restricted Malaysia to 208 for 9 from 50 overs.

But in reply, they were guilty of a terrible start and found themselves on 65 for 7, and were all but out of the game.

But a stand of 96 between David Hooper and Tom Kimber put the Sarnians back on track.

Then wicketkeeper Kimber and Jamie Nussbaumer saw the Greens to victory in the last over with 3 balls to spare. The tension was unbelievable and the scenes of joy after unrestrained.

Kimber was named man-of-the-match for his 82 not out while Guernsey all-rounder Jeremy Frith was named player-of-the-tournament.

Division Five will be played in Singapore in February where the island side will take on the hosts, Malaysia, Argentina, Bahrain and the Cayman Islands.
